10k Dream Team - Competition rules

Team Selection

- 1) The charity draft order will be randomly picked during the Draft Day meeting.
- 2) The charities will draft athletes based on the following order:

Charity #1	Charity #2	Charity #3	Charity #4
1	2	3	4
8	7	6	5
9	10	11	12
16	15	14	13

- 3) Athletes will be awarded prize dollars based on when they get drafted.

Draft Position	Amount
1 st	\$4,000
2 nd	\$3,000
3 rd	\$2,000
4 th	\$1,000
5 th	\$750
6 th	\$600
7 th	\$500
8 th	\$500

- 4) All 14 Gold Label athletes must be selected. There are only 2 wild-card spots that can be picked from the remaining elite field.

After the draft

If a selected athlete cannot make the race (for example gets injured), the charity will be contacted to select another athlete from the elite field. This is valid until Wednesday, May 23rd.

After Wednesday, May 23rd, if a selected athlete cannot start the race or does not finish, the athlete will be assigned 16 points.

Scoring

All 16 athletes in the team competition will be assigned a point based on their finishing position against the other athletes in the team competition.

So, 1st across the finish line will get 1 point, 2nd will get 2 points, 3rd will get points.

The points of the top 3 athletes of each team will added to determine the team score.

The team with the least points wins. The team with the second least points gets second and so on.

If there is a tie between teams, the following tie-breakers will be used in this order:

- 1) a comparison of the result of the 4th placed athlete on each team (lowest point wins)
- 2) use a comparison of the 3rd place athlete of each team.
- 3) use a comparison of the 2nd place athlete of each team.
- 4) use a comparison of the 1st place athlete of each team.
- 5) declare a tie and share the prize.

An athlete that does not finish or does not start will be awarded an automatic 16pts.

Note: Gender gap for 2018 will be 3min 40sec. meaning that the women will leave 3 min. and 40 seconds before the men, allowing them to finish the race at roughly the same time.
